ABOUT US

Early Head Start is a federal early education program for income eligible families expecting a child, or with children from birth to age 3 years old. Children and families who participate in Early Head Start are offered a variety of services that promote cognitive, language and social-emotional development of the child. Children also receive free medical and dental screenings, and families are provided with assistance locating health care providers whenever needed.

QUALITY EARLY EDUCATION

Early Head Start provides children and families with education experiences in their home for expecting mothers and children from birth to age 3. Full year classroom options are available for children age 18 months to 3 years old.

HOME-BASED PROGRAM

In the home-based program, our experienced educators work with parents as the primary teachers of their children. Activities revolve around the individual needs of the child. Visits focus on educational development, include developmental assessments and are held once per week in the client's home. Socialization experiences are provided for children and families twice per month.

CLASSROOM PROGRAM

A full-year classroom option is available for children age 18 months to 3 years old. Our exceptional staff of early education teachers focus on activities and curriculum that are fun and engaging for the children, while preparing them for pre-school.
